



The BeTalent Decision Styles questionnaire and card sort exercise, developed by Dr Amanda Potter, were scientifically researched and designed to measure an individual's decision style, risk taking and judgement behaviours.

The BeTalent Decision Styles Model

The BeTalent Decision Styles Model is based on 10 decision-making factors, mapped to the BeTalent Behaviours, Expertise, Strengths and Tenets. The scores reflect how extreme an individual's results are compared to a norm group of global professionals. Each style has an opposing style on a continuum, for example, single-minded and open-minded.

How does it work?

Users complete a 12-minute secure questionnaire on the BeTalent App or online platform. Full interpretive reports summarise an individual's decision-making preferences, highlighting their primary, secondary and agile decision-making styles. The report also identifies clear learning and development opportunities for the future, in order to enhance future decision-making competence.

What are the benefits of using the Decision Styles Questionnaire?

Focusing on the ways you and your organisation approach and make decisions will help to:

- Increase self-awareness and an understanding of what people pay attention to, in order to make better informed decisions;
- Encourage open discussions about Decision Styles in order to improve decision making;
- Enhance your awareness of how your colleagues think and act. These individual styles often influence how problems and potential solutions are evaluated (Martinsons, 2001);
- Better understand how your Decision Styles impact the way in which you work independently and with others;
- Reflect upon instances whereby your Decision Styles may be less effective; under certain circumstances, working with certain colleagues.

The cognitive diversity of the team and how they make decisions is key to the creativity and success of that decision.

How much does it cost?

The cost for the Decision Styles questionnaire is £45 and for the online card sort is £40 per person (not including administration). The Decision Styles Card Sort Packs are £25 per box.
